HARD ROCK CASINO-NORTHERN INDIANA OPENING MAY 14, 2021

Hard Rock International announced Tuesday that its new land-based casino in Gary, Hard Rock Casino-Northern Indiana, will open its doors to the public on May 14. Highlights of a week-long celebration will be, a Friends and Family event taking place on May 11, with a VIP only opening on May 13.

Hard Rock International and Spectacle Entertainment are partners in the \$300 million Gary project. The casino complex, is located off Interstate 80/94 at the Burr Street exit.

COVID-19 VACCINE



Governor Eric J. Holcomb delivered a statewide address to lay out the road ahead for Hoosiers in the fight against COVID-19.

The state public health

emergency will be renewed for another 30 days, beginning April 1. The state plans to open vaccine eligibility to all Hoosiers 16 years and older on Wednesday, March 31, provided Indiana receives a large increase in the amount of vaccine as outlined by the federal government. Additional mass vaccination clinics will be scheduled for April and the state will implement a large employer vaccination program.

The statewide face covering mandate will become a mask advisory on April 6. Face coverings will remain mandatory in all state buildings and facilities. Mayor Jerome Prince says the city of Gary's mask mandate will stay in place until April 8, will COVID-19 numbers are tracked.

Gov. Holcomb said. "It's up to each and every one of us to do our part to stay on our course."

Mass Vaccination Site to Open at Gary's Roosevelt High School

Indiana Governor Eric J. Holcomb, together with the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), announced that an eight-week mass vaccination clinic with the capacity to administer 3,000 COVID-19 vaccines a day will open in Gary. A total of 2,000 vaccine doses per day will be administered at the Gary location. A media bliss will take place on April 6 beginning promptly at 10:30am for the vaccination process RSVP to the Chamber for this event.

The clinic will run from April 7 to June 2 on the grounds of the former Roosevelt High School, 730 W. 25th Ave., Gary. The vaccination clinic will be a drive-thru or walk-thru operation from 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. CDT seven days a week and will offer first doses of the Pfizer vaccine during the first three weeks of operation and will be guaranteed a second dose during the fourth, fifth, and sixth weeks of the clinic. The single-dose Johnson & Johnson vaccine will be administered the final two weeks of the operation.
